

## CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

**LEADLINE:** Open to any rider **10 years and under** who has not shown at the trot in any horse show. Riders to be led at the walk in both directions of the ring. Open to horses and ponies. Points to follow rider.

**WALK:** Open to any rider **10 years and under** who has not shown at the trot at any horse show. Open to horses and ponies. Riders to be judged at the walk in both directions of the ring. Points to follow rider. For equitation, judge will ask for posting position. For poles, riders will be asked to stand in the middle and each rider will be asked to individually walk over poles.

**JUNIOR WALK/TROT:** Open to any rider **12 years old and under as of January 1<sup>st</sup>**, who has not shown at the canter at any horse show. Open to horses and ponies. Riders to be judged both directions of the ring both at a walk and trot. Equitation class judged on the rider. For poles, riders will be asked to stand in the middle and each rider will be asked to individually go over poles. Points to follow rider. A horse/rider combination may show in either the Walk/Trot or the Walk/Trot/Canter, but not both classes. May cross enter into the crossrails division.

**SENIOR WALK/TROT:** Open to any rider **13 years and over as of January 1<sup>st</sup>** who has not shown at the canter at any horse show. Open to horses and ponies. Riders to be judged both directions of the ring both at a walk and trot. Equitation class judged on the rider. For poles, riders will be asked to stand in the middle and each rider will be asked to individually go over poles. Points to follow rider. A horse/rider combination may show in either the Walk/Trot or the Walk/Trot/Canter, but not both classes.

**CROSSRAILS HUNTER/EQUITATION:** Open to all riders who have never jumped higher than 18" and have **less than 2 years of showing experience**. Open to horses and ponies. **Trot entire crossrail course or may trot into lines and canter in the middle of line, but must trot all corners of the course**. Classes judged on manners, way of going and suitability of mount. Flat-class will be walk/trot only. Points to follow rider. May cross enter into Junior Walk/Trot division.

**MINI STIRRUP HUNTER/EQUITATION:** Open to riders of any age, who have never jumped higher than 18" and have **less than 2 years of showing experience**. Open to horse and ponies. Crossrail course may be done at a trot or a canter. Classes judged on manners, way of going and suitability of mount. Flat-class will be walk/trot/canter. Points to follow rider. May not cross enter into Junior or Senior crossrails divisions.

**18" HUNTER/EQUITATION:** Limited to Junior & Amateur horse/rider combination, who have not shown over fences higher than 18". Open to all age groups, horses and ponies. Hunter classes judged on performance and soundness. Suitability of mount is emphasized. Equitation classes judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of mount. Jumps at 18". Hunter points to follow horse. Equitation points to follow rider. May not cross-enter to any other division.

**2' HUNTER/EQUITATION:** Limited to Junior & Amateur horse/rider combination, who have not shown over fences higher than 2'. Open to all age groups, horses and ponies. Hunter classes judged on performance and soundness. Suitability of mount is emphasized. Equitation classes judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of mount. Jumps at 2'. Hunter points to follow horse. Equitation points to follow rider. May not cross-enter to any other division.

**LIMIT HUNTER/EQUITATION:** Limited to junior & amateur horse/rider combination, who have not shown over fences higher than 2'3 at any show. Open to all ages, horses and ponies. Hunter classes judged on performance and soundness. Suitability of mount is emphasized. Equitation classes judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of mount. Jumps at 2 –2'3ft". Hunter points to follow horse. Equitation points to follow rider. May not cross-enter to any other division.

**LOW HUNTER/EQUITATION:** Hunter open to all riders. **Equitation open to junior and amateur riders only**. Open to horses and ponies. Fences height 2'6". Hunter class is judged on performance, soundness, and way of going and suitability of mount. Hunter Points to follow the horse. Equitation classes to be judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of mount. Equitation points to follow rider. If less than 3 entries, judging will be combined with Cheval Hunter/Equitation.

**FEATHERSTONE JUMPER:** Open to any rider regardless of age and status. Open to horses and ponies. Declare your fence height WT Crossrails, WTC crossrails, 18", 2', 2'3" or 2'6". Jumper classes are run on Saturday evening at 5pm.
